

WORDS

INSTIGATE

Incite someone to do something, specially something bad / भड़काना

1. There has been an increase in the amount of violence **instigated** by gangs.
2. The government has **instigated** an investigation into the cause of the accident.

BREACH

failing to do what is required by a law, an agreement, or a duty / उल्लंघन

1. This is clearly a **breach** of the treaty.
2. He was fined for committing a **breach** of the peace.

APPOSITE

very appropriate for a particular situation or in relation to something, relevant/ उचित

1. Her remarks are extremely **apposite** to the present discussion.
2. His conclusions remain **apposite** today.

COMPLEMENT

Providing something additional to enhance something act of persisting / दृढ़ता

1. At the moment we have a full **complement** of staff.
2. Just 79 of the ship's **complement** of 284 souls survived.

NEGLECT

Failing to care for/ अवज्ञा

1. He **neglects** that poor dog – he never takes him for walks or gives him any attention.
2. She's been **neglecting** her studies this semester.

WORDS

ASSERTIVE

Having or showing a confident personality/
निश्चय

1

1. We need to be bold and **assertive**.
2. Britain today is less **assertive** and confident.

DIABOLICAL

Disgracefully bad or unpleasant / दुष्ट

2

1. Her **diabolical** approach to things is concerning.
2. Sometimes being **diabolical** is the only option in today's world.

COMPROMISE

Settling a dispute by mutual agreement /
समझौता

3

1. This deal requires a great **compromise** from our side.
2. We will not **compromise** on safety.

CONFIDENTIAL

Intended to be kept secret/ गुप्त

4

1. This information needs to be kept **confidential** from anyone.
2. We cannot compromise on the **confidentiality** of our organisation.

ECSTATIC

Overwhelmingly happy / उत्साहित

5

1. She was **ecstatic** to see her brother's trophy.
2. Sally was **ecstatic** about her new job.

WORDS

PARTIAL

1

of or relating to a part rather than the whole / अधूरा

1. The court was **partial** towards the mayor.
2. You know, I'm very **partial** to what you are saying here.

PARANOID

2

being obsessively unreasonably anxious/ संविभ्रमी

1. You think I'm **paranoid** but I tell you there is something going on.
2. Sometimes it's tough being shy and I feel a bit **paranoid**.

INSTANTANEOUSLY

3

done without any delay being purposely introduced / तत्काल

1. Participants in chat rooms respond **instantaneously** to each other.
2. Electronic copies can be sent around the world almost **instantaneously**.

AMMALGAMATE

4

to merge into a single body/ मिलाना

1. They **amalgamated** the hospital with the university.
2. The firm has **amalgamated** with an American company.

CIRCULATE

5

to go around or through something / घूमना

1. A pump **circulates** the water through the filter.
2. Rumours are **circulating** around town.

WORDS

DYNAMIC

1

Constantly changing / बदलते रहना

- 1.The **dynamic** content of these sites keeps their audience informed and up to date.
- 2.She's a very **dynamic** person.

CONCEDE

2

Give over/ स्वीकार

- 1.I had to **concede** that this was true.
- 2.We were forced to **concede** to their demands.

DESCENT

3

A movement downward / चढ़ाई

- 1.The **descent** drops straight into the sump with no place to rest.
- 2.The **descent** to base camp is steep and rocky.

IMMINENT

4

Close in time, about to occur/ करीब

- 1.They were in **imminent** danger of being swept away.
- 2.That leaves the question of how immediate or **imminent** the threatened violence needs to be.

MULTITUDE

5

A large indefinite number / भीड़

- 1.There is a **multitude** of reasons against it.
- 2.I had never seen such a **multitude** of stars before.

WORDS

BOOST

1

to increase, encourage or improve something / बढ़ाना

1. The company is looking for ways to **boost** sales in Asia, its biggest market.
2. I tried to **boost** his morale by praising his cooking.

FABRICATE

2

to invent in order to deceive / जाली बनाना

1. Only the largest parts were **fabricated** at the factory.
2. Their plan is to **fabricate** the house out of synthetic materials.

EXTENSIVE

3

covering a large area or amount / लंबा-चौड़ा

1. There is an **extensive** repertoire of music written for the flute.
2. Several of the crash victims had to have **extensive** plastic surgery.

INTENSE

4

very great in degree, extreme force/ अत्यधिक

1. The heat was **intense**.
2. Under **intense** pressure it was forced to yield him.

ACCESS

5

approach or permission to enter / पहुँच

1. Investigators wanted to get **access** to his home.
2. Consultants who have easy **access** to the president.
