

WORDS

ASSIST

1

Help someone, typically by doing a share of work/ सहायता देना

1. He scored a fine goal and also claimed an **assist**.
2. I offered to **assist** them with their children's school fees.

PARCH

2

Make or become dry through extreme heat/ सूखा

1. With the sun shining so brightly, it was not difficult to **parch** the wet clothing.
2. Hours after my last drink of water, my throat began to **parch**.

COMPETENT

3

Having the necessary ability, knowledge or skill to do something successfully/ सक्षम

1. She has shown herself to be a highly **competent** manager.
2. He's extremely **competent** and industrious.

LEVERAGE

4

To use something you already have to achieve something new or better/ फ़ायदा उठाना

1. My spade hit something solid that wouldn't respond to **leverage**
2. The union's power gave it great **leverage** in the negotiations

DIVERSIFY

5

Make or become more diverse or varied/ अनेक

1. We need to **diversify** to gain new customers.
2. They are trying to **diversify** the economy so as to reduce their reliance on oil.

WORDS

SOPHISTICATED

1

having a refined knowledge of the ways of the world cultivated especially through wide experience / विवेकी

1. She was a **sophisticated** and well-traveled woman.
2. She has **sophisticated** tastes

GLUT

2

a supply of something that is much more than can be sold or is needed or wanted/ भरमार

1. The fall in demand for coffee could cause a **glut** in the market.
2. The current **glut** of graduates means that many of them will not be able to find jobs.

VERSATILE

3

able to do many different things or to adjust to new conditions / बहुमुखी

1. He was a **versatile** guitarist, and recorded with many leading rock bands.
2. It is an especially **versatile** insecticide known to control a range of insects.

DILIGENT

4

careful and hardworking/ परिश्रमी

1. Their lawyer was extremely **diligent** in preparing their case.
2. The discovery was made after years of **diligent** research.

REINFORCEMENT

5

the action of strengthening or encouraging something / सहायक सेना

1. They are working on the **reinforcement** of the sea-wall.
2. The details are a **reinforcement** of the impression we had already got.

WORDS

GULLIBLE

1

Easily persuaded to believe something / आसानी से धोखा खानेवाला

1. I'm not **gullible** enough to believe something that outrageous.
2. They sell overpriced souvenirs to **gullible** tourists.

STATIONARY

2

Not moving or not intended to be moved / अचल

1. The whole place was **stationary** with nothing moving at all.
2. There is a ten mile queue of **stationary** traffic on the motorway.

ASSENT

3

The expression of approval and agreement / अनुमति

1. She nodded her **assent**.
2. The act was given the Royal **Assent**.

DISTINCT

4

Something that is clearly distant or separate from another/ अलग

1. Faces in the crowd grew more **distinct** as I got nearer.
2. His style is quite **distinct** from Monet's.

DISTANT

5

Far away in time or space/ दूर

1. The star is 30,000 light years **distant** from Earth.
2. The **distant** bark of some farm dog"

WORDS

INFERIOR

1

low or lower in position, quality, importance etc. / नीचा

1. These products are **inferior** to those we bought last year.
2. She cited cases in which women had received **inferior** healthcare.

FLATTER

2

giving someone compliments or praise to make them feel pretty and smart/ बढ़ाना चढ़ाना

1. He **flattered** her with comments about her youthful appearance.
2. His comments **flattered** her.

SOLITUDE

3

the state of being alone, in a good way / अकेलापन

1. All was peace, light and **solitude** – which can do strange things to a person."
2. Yet we have a better chance of **solitude** here than on most islands.

AMENITIES

4

desirable facilities of a place or a building / सुविधायें

1. The local roads, services, **amenities**, houses and schools are not large enough.
2. He also pointed out the concerns over traffic and the lack of **amenities**.

ORIGIN

5

a place where something has been born has risen from / प्रारंभिक

1. The disorder in military policy had its **origins** in Truman's first term.
2. Their medical problems are basically physical in origin.

WORDS

ASTRONOMICAL

1

Improperly forward or bold / धृष्ट

1. It would be **impertinent** to suggest that he was always wrong.
2. She found the question highly **impertinent**.

WHETHER

2

Affording satisfaction or pleasure / संतोषजनक

1. He felt a **gratifying** sense of being respected and appreciated.
2. It is **gratifying** to see such good results

VENDETTA

3

Making something easier to understand / नहीं रखना

1. We are trying to **demystify** the workings of government.
2. Let's **demystify** the event by explaining what it is all about.

EMPATHY

4

The act of persisting / दृढ़ता

1. Does she have the **perseverance** to finish the work?
2. His **perseverance** with the new technique paid off

PERTINENT

5

Turn away from, give up/ त्यागना

1. No one wants to **relinquish** power once they have it.
2. We can assume that the European Council will not voluntarily **relinquish** the power to appoint.
